2022-2023 HAS BEEN AN EXCITING YEAR FOR OUR LEAGUE, AN EVER-EXPANDING GROUP OF DEDICATED WOMEN WHO POSITIVELY IMPACT OUR COMMUNITY. AS PART OF OUR COMMUNITY INITIATIVE, A LEAGUE OF LEARNERS, WE CONTINUED TO PARTNER WITH MONTESSORI ELEMENTARY AT HIGHLAND PARK, HOSTING MONTHLY KIDS IN THE KITCHEN COOKING CLASSES FOR THIRD-GRADE STUDENTS, AND, IN PART THROUGH CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP, AWARDED \$18,000 IN MINI. GRANTS TO HAMILTON COUNTY EDUCATORS TO FUND CREATIVE TEACHING PROJECTS FOR STUDENTS.

IN NOVEMBER, WE HOSTED OUR ANNUAL TOUCH-A.TRUCK COMMUNITY FUNDRAISER-OUR LARGEST EVENT YET-WITH OVER 2,000 ATTENDEES, RAISING \$10,300 IN TICKET INCOME.

OUR DIVERSITY, EQUITY, INCLUSION, AND BELONGING COUNCIL AND LEADERSHIP training committee invited stimulating speakers and organized IMPACTFUL TRAINING TO FOSTER INCLUSIVITY AND DIVERSITY WHILE SUPPORTING OUR MISSION TO EMPOWER WOMEN AS CIVIC LEADERS THROUGH LEADERSHIP TRAINING AND VOLUNTARISM.
